EARLY COLLEGE


HS student enrolls in college course(s), starting with introductory course and eventually paired with related job or internship.

HS student/graduate is hired for an entry-level job, possibly within the field of study, while completing credit sequence for degree. Greater work experience and responsibilities lead to a profession in the field and post-secondary degree. Work experience and related education lead to a higher salary for the graduate.


College & Career Readiness Early College Team Increasing # of Off Track Students Served at CCSF

College & Career Readiness Early College Team Changing WHO is served at CCSF






Adult Ed Participants Over Time






AEP Participant Data
